Sports For Learning alignment with Title III Funds

Funding is made available for eligible districts to provide supplementary programs and services to English Learner (EL) students. Due to the use of our bi-lingual instructors, many schools will adopt the SFL program as a targeted intervention for their EL students. The SFL Student Workbook, available in [English](#) and [Spanish](#), contains key vocabulary and concepts that are specific to curriculum requirements for all students.

The SFL program meets funding requirements through providing a targeted language acquisition program where students get to test their literary skills and abilities both inside and outside the classroom. This is accomplished in a number of ways:

- **STEM Workbook:**

This workbook, provided in English and Spanish, contains key vocabulary words and concepts specific to their grade level and NGSS aligned.

- **The Phrase That Pays:**

For each lesson, students must learn and repeat a rhyming phrase that helps them remember specific STEM words and concepts. These phrases are delivered by the instructor on the sports field on an ongoing basis throughout each game.

- **Bi-lingual Instructors:**

Although our lessons are taught in English, SFL hires instructors with the ability to speak the same language as the majority of the students they are teaching.

- **Actions and Demonstration:**

Our instructors will act out the key words that the students will need to recall in order to help with memory retention.
